



SOCAL LEAGUE



SOCAL is the premier Southern California-based youth competitive local soccer league that offers programs for players U7-U19, boys and girls. This program is a great starting platform for all young players looking to progress through the different levels of the player pathway our club provides while keeping travel and expenses low. All of our elite players start their journey in this league which provides various skill levels, identified as flights that range from 1-4 & NPL.

Teams begin forming immediately after tryouts. Tryouts typically begin in January and/or February (up to U12); May (U13+). Dates differ by Age Groups

- Player commitment is through the end of State Cup play for all age groups
- All teams will have a preseason meeting detailing the season plan along with costs and collection dates for any additional tournaments beyond the subsidy
- League Season is September-November
- 3-5 tournaments in the Summer
- Winter Tournaments including State Cup
- The season ends after State Cup: Late January/mid February for U12 and under; May for U13 and older
- Games can be on Saturday AND/OR Sunday
- Games are typically within an hour's drive of Los Alamos
- Tournaments are selected by the DOC and coaching staff
- The club contributes funds that typically cover the cost of 2 tournaments
- Any additional tournament costs are covered by the parents
- Training is typically 2 times a week @ Los Alamos Sports Park
- Typical training slots are 5:00 p.m.-6:30 p.m./6:30 p.m.-8:00 p.m./8:00 p.m.-9:30 p.m.
- Uniform Kits are changed every odd calendar year (Current Cycle 2023-2024 - Next Cycle 2025-2026)
- Kits include mandatory and optional items
- Player and Parent Club Expectations Guidelines are provided on the website
- Every player will receive player evaluations from their coach each season, this is reviewed by both the player and the parent
- Older teams (U15-U19) take a break from the end of November to around the end of February, for the High School Season
